Best Time: Mid June to Sept.

Launch: Sandy, single beach.

Wind Direction: Sideshore from the left.

Wind Type: Meltemi, accelerated by thermal in the afternoon.

Shorebreak: Moderate, occasionally strong.

Water Conditions: In shore small waves with windchop, on the outside wave with swell.

Suitability: Intermediate sea sailors+.

KITE PRO CENTRE Instruction only

Kite area: Located on Kremasti Beach, less busy & 3kms from Blue Horizon, wide and open. Wind sideshore from left. Kitezone well away from windsurfing areas for all levels. North Kiteboarding boards and kites. No storage available. Kite hire not available.

Instruction: All levels. Windsurf - beginners max 6/group. Adv – max 3/group with video analysis. Kitesurf – courses in 3 hr sessions.

Other Sports: Cycling, Tennis, Volleyball, Exercise, Sailing & motorised watersports.

Excursions: Rhodes Town. Scooter & car hire for island excursions. Waterpark.



The Spot & Sailing Conditions

The beach at lalysos faces a large open bay, shallow for the first 20m, with the clean Meltemi wind blowing cross onshore from the left. This produces a moderate shorebreak but once launched it is possible to blast across the bay at speed. Outside the bay, the swell forms superb jumping ramps. The wind here is typically a gentle force 2 to 3 in the morning, more suited to the less experienced. More gusty afternoons with 1.5m chop on the outside and often Force 5 and above in July and August.



Blue Horizon



Location: Positioned on the sandy and shingle beach surrounded by beautiful tropical gardens 15 minutes from airport.

Accommodation: 220 comfortably furnished and air conditioned rooms equipped with ensuite bathroom with shower/WC, telephone,



radio, satellite TV, mini fridge and safe. Bungalow style properties are located in the gardens for up to 4 people.

Facilities: Buffet style restaurant, beach snack bar, main bar, swimming pool, children's pool, tennis, volleyball, mini club (summer season), animation programme and regular evening entertainment. Internet access is also available.

Windsurfing/Kitesurfing: F2 Pro Centre located on the beach next to the hotel.

Location: Set back from beach, within popular complex amongst extensive gardens. Approximately 20 minutes drive from the airport.

Accommodation: Studio apartments within the Sun Beach Resort. Each with kitchenette, fridge, ensuite bathroom, IDD telephone and air conditioning in the summer.



Facilities: Main restaurant, a la carte restaurant and variety of bars. Access to 2 swimming pools, children's pools, & playground, tennis courts, mini golf, table tennis & other recreations sports. Fitness centre, saunas, jacuzzi & massage. Internet access.

Windsurfing/Kitesurfing: F2 Pro Centre 10 minutes walk. 1km from lalysos centre.
