The main port and island capital is Kos Town situated on the north east coast. It is a place of architectural beauty, abundant greenery, tree lined avenues and pretty flower filled squares. You will find the hub of island life here, under a shady palm, in one of the many restaurants, bars and shops. Only 6km south east from Kos town is the quieter resort of Psalidi. A fabulous beach provides the setting for some amazing windsurfing. Mountain biking and walking are also very popular here. Dedicated cycle lanes are all over the Island and guided walks take place in the hills of Psalidi.

The Spot & Sailing Conditions

The 'Meltemi' wind blows consistently in the summer from the north/northwest, delivery a cross shore wind from the left. The average strength is for 4-6 with some days up to 7-8 in July and August. The sheltered launch is great for beginners and kids. Once past the slight shore break, this affords sensational slalom blasting with swell up to 1m on the outside. A safe sailing area with lots of space on the water and dedicated Baywatch and rescue service. As well as stunning views whilst sailing, the proximity of Turkey and Kos create a wind funnel system giving stronger winds than other spots on the island.



Hotel Oceanis



Location: Approximately 28 km from the airport and 6 km from Kos Town. Located on the beach at Psalidi set in large and spectacular gardens.

Accommodation: 365 comfortable air conditioned rooms feature a private bathroom, fridge, satellite TV, safe, telephone and a balcony or terrace. Sea view rooms are available. Presidential Suites have all of the above plus living room, 2 marble bathrooms, king size bed, 2 Sat TVs, sea view, terrace, mini bar, connecting doors and safe.

Facilities: 4 different swimming pools consisting of 2 salt water, 1 fresh water and a children's pool and sun terraces. Two restaurants, beach bar, swim up pool bar, coffee shop. Mini markets, beauty salon, mini club, kid's playground, babysitting, evening entertainment and internet access. Activities - tennis courts, saunas, jacuzzi and massage, (these are charged for locally) basketball/volleyball, fitness studio, aerobics, archery, table tennis, waterpolo, mini golf, snorkelling and fishing from the jetty.

Windsurfing: The Fanatic Boarders Centre is based here.
