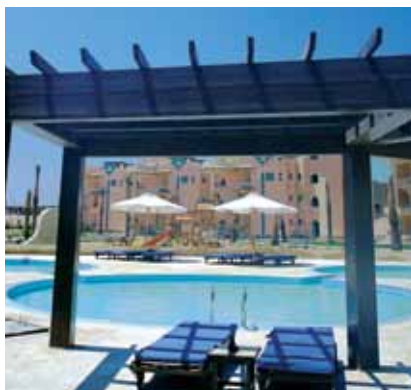
For Egypt the Suez Canal has been a source of wealth for decades. Less than 80 kilometers south of the canal mouth and a three hour drive away from Cairo we have discovered a new source. Not a source of wealth and luxury, but a unique oasis for windsurfers and kites. Here the undeveloped resorts of Ras Sudr and El Tur offers some of the best conditions in the whole of the Red Sea for windsurfers and kites alike of all levels.

Ras Sudr is known for its wide flat, turquoise water bay, the finest of sandy beaches and a 1km long coastal strip with no reefs or pebbles. The sandbank encloses a tidal lagoon with waist high water, where clean, consistent winds are perfect for freeride and freestyle. A moderate morning breeze and flat water are ideal conditions for beginners. The north to north east wind blows sideshore to side offshore, building through the morning hours until it reaches its peak in the afternoon. This spot can be described as the ultimate venue for maximum water time.

Green Sudr



Location: Approximately 3 hours from Cairo airport and 4 hours from Sharm El Sheikh. 10 km south of Ras Sudr on the beach.



Accommodation: The hotel has a total of 136 rooms. Guests are accommodated mainly in the front wings with view of the Red Sea. The three-story sea front blocks contain standard rooms and suites. The standard rooms are equipped with either one king size bed or twin beds, bath/WC with air conditioning, satellite TV and mini bar and balcony. The suites are more spacious and also offer a sitting area and some suites have a separate bedroom.

Facilities: The spacious hotel houses a large lobby with 24 hrs reception, a restaurant with wide terrace, roof terrace, billiard room, three conference rooms as well as tennis, volleyball and basketball courts and a swimming pool with pool and snack bar. Large children's pool and playground in hotel grounds. During the day the beach bar offers cool drinks.

Windsurfing/Kitesurfing: Club Mistral/Skyriders satellite centre in front of hotel. Main centre approximately 15 minutes walk along the beach.
